- \$225.00 PER RESIDENT-CHILD(REN)
- Parent(s) attending with their children will be admitted to all activities in the Summer Program for a one time charge of \$10.00 (excluding the charges listed below for “Special Events”)
- \$350.00 per visiting Grandchild
- \$ 90.00 per visiting Grandchild for two weeks. A “temporary” card (non-renewable) will be issued good for any two-week period.

- Each family member **must have** a photo ID card in order to participate in the 2010 Summer Youth Program.
- Parents must bring proof of residency (driver’s license, utility bill, etc... and child’s report card or birth certificate. **Falsification of residency or age will result in the forfeiture of all fees and suspension of camp.**
- Registration is not official until all forms have been completed and turned in, and payment received. Release, Indemnification and Emergency Medical Authorization must be signed by Parent or Legal Guardian and witness at registration.

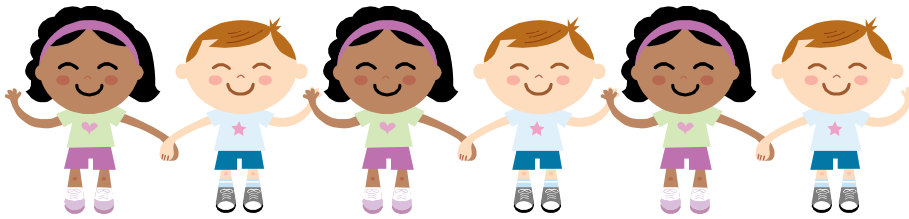

## **Gymnastics**

## **Trampoline**

## **Cheerleading**

If your daughter wants to have fun, this class is for her. Cheers, chants and pompom routines are taught in this 60-minute fun-filled class.

## **Award Winning Martial Arts**

**(Ages 8 & up)**

Instructor Brandon Fisher (6<sup>th</sup> Degree Black Belt with 24 yrs of experience) students will learn basic blocks, strikes, kicks stances and our first kata (form) over five 1-hour classes. We are sure you will have a great experience and want to continue training and learning for a lifetime. Each student will be given the opportunity to learn the basics of traditional Okinawa Shorin Ryu Karate-Do as it is taught on the island of Okinawa, Japan today.

## **Fitness Boot Camp**

Students will learn the importance of cardio exercise and strength training using King's Fitness Center and weight room. You will learn proper technique on various exercises and how to put it together an exercise program. Students will be supervised by certified fitness trainers. The importance of proper eating habits will also be covered.

## **Etiquette & Lifestyles**

**(Girls Only)**

It's all about you! Have fun learning make-up techniques, good manners, classy dressing, hair and nail care, and how to develop confidence and poise. Role-playing, handouts and hands on activities included.

## **Young Actors Workshop**

Early exposure to theater arts is an excellent way to build a child's sense of confidence and self-esteem. Beginning acting concepts will be introduced through games featuring concentration, projection and diction. Students will have fun exploring mime, improvisation, skits and scripts reading. Don't be "shy" give it a "try."

## **Advance Theater Experience**

For budding actors and actresses who have already taken the "Young Actor's Workshop" and want to further improve skills in acting, dance and vocal performance. This class is led by artist from local theaters (Young Actor's Workshop is a prerequisite).

## **Digital Video Production**

This course has been updated to include more special effects, post-production activity and acting. Students will learn manual focus, shot composition and techniques for producing quality video while shooting in the field using advanced digital video cameras. Student will enjoy bringing their action movie vision to life (ex short documentaries, ads) and special effects software like One lerra on furnished laptops. Each student get to take home a DVD of their work. Students (ages 8 – 15) working in teams of 3 – 5 and no experience required. **Limit 20.**

## **Decorative Cultural Arts**

**(Five 2-hour classes)**

This year's theme for the arts and crafts classes will be Decorative Cultural Arts. This is a variety of cultural mediums that will include black and white Chinese brush painting, printmaking using African designs, Asian scenes on grass clothe screens, Mexican yarn work and Native Indian jewelry.
