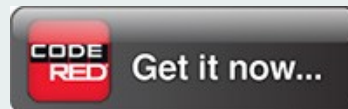
SIGN UP FOR CODE-RED!

IT TAKES A VILLAGE

We've all heard it takes a Village as it relates to families and children, but it also relates to keeping our community beautiful.

As we transition from traditional rubbish containers to Waste Management's (WM) new trucks and containers, there are other changes as well.

- ◆ WM will pick up large items; appliances, furniture, etc. but you must first call WM at 866-797-90180 to schedule a special pickup.
- ◆ Furniture must be entirely wrapped in plastic and securely taped prior to being put out on the curb.
- ◆ Securely locked rubbish cans can be put on the curb after 7pm Sunday and put back by Monday evening after pickup.

We had about 70 vehicles come through with about 3,000 pounds shredded which will save 25 trees and 6000 kw electricity.
