Richmond Road between Buckthorn Road and East Hawthorne Parkway, will be closed to allow for the replacement/repair work on the railroad crossing starting on October 8th. It will reopen on October 15th. This will be full closure, no emergency access will be permissible during the construction period. Fall Leaf Collection

The Oakwood Service Department will begin its Fall program in mid-October. Rake leaves onto your tree lawn and remove branches, twigs, rocks and other debris. Piles that contain items other than leaves WILL NOT be picked up. If you have branches or brush, you may tie them into small bundles no more than 4-feet long for regular Monday pick up. Do not place leaves in the roadway. The Service Department will make recurring trips around the Village.

For those of us with dogs, please keep your pet on a leash when walking. Also, please remember to clean-up after them. We want to all our residents to feel safe. Also, do not dispose of trash on the streets while walking and or driving. Keep safe and beautiful Oakwood clean and beautiful.
