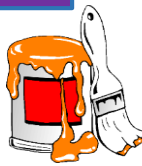

Annual Scrap Tire & Old Paint Can Round-up

Thu. Sep 19th



LIMIT: 10 tires per house
Rims must be removed
No tires larger than 20 inches

➤ Old cans of paint, pesticides, & other hazardous household chemicals, phone books & computer equipment may also be placed out for collection.

➤ **NO LATEX PAINT.** To dispose of it, just open the lid to let the paint dry out and become a solid. Then put it out with your regular trash.

Please place all disposables in an orderly fashion on the tree lawn next to your mailbox. **EVERYTHING MUST BE OUT FOR PICK-UP BY 7:30 A.M. THURSDAY.**

Fall Leaf Collection

The Oakwood Service Department will begin its **FALL PROGRAM IN MID-OCTOBER.** Rake leaves onto your tree lawn and remove branches, twigs, rocks and other debris. **Piles that contain items other than leaves WILL NOT be picked up.** If you have branches or brush, you may tie them into small bundles no more than 4-feet long for regular Monday trash pick up. Do not place leaves in the roadway. The Service Dept. will make recurring trips around the Village until the weather becomes inclement.
