
#### **RESOLUTION 2019-11**

## A RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION TO SERGEANT REED

**WHEREAS**, Cameron Reed was hired as a part-time Patrol Officer for the Village of Oakwood in 2012. Due to his exceptional skills and knowledge, Officer Reed was awarded a full-time position in 2013, and in 2017 he was promoted to Sergeant; and

**WHEREAS**, his continuous training and skills were demonstrated on August 11, 2018, when Janet Taylor, 52, of California, was driving southbound on I-271 in the single-flow lane while in a construction zone, when she went into full cardiac arrest; and

**WHEREAS**, while performing his duty in the construction zone, Sergeant Reed was alerted by another driver of a driver in crises. With little thought for his own safety, he jumped into action, pulled Ms. Taylor from her vehicle and immediately administered CPR, saving her life; and

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter, Hudson EMS personnel were returning from an emergency call and saw the need to stop to give assistance. With the help of Kokosing Construction workers, who moved construction barriers, the emergency personnel were able to move their equipment close enough to assist Sgt. Reed and attend to Ms. Taylor; and

**WHEREAS**, the quick actions of Sergeant Reed, put into action the saving of Ms. Janet Taylor's life, in addition to the quick response of motorists, the Hudson EMS and Kokosing Construction workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oakwood is grateful to have officers on its force, as Sergeant Reed, who serves as an example to the bravery of our hard-working Officers. He also gives honor to not only the Village of Oakwood Police Department, but to departments everywhere who unselfishly serve their communities every day; and

**NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT** by the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:
