

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-71

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE  
COUNTY AUDITOR TO ADVANCE THE SUMS  
ALLOWED BY LAW FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX  
LEVIES IN THE ACCOUNT OF THE VILLAGE OF  
OAKWOOD, PURSUANT TO SECTION 321.34 OF THE  
OHIO REVISED CODE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 321.34 of the Ohio revised Code provides that any and all tax revenue and the payment of special assessments held in the County Treasury to the account of the Village of Oakwood, and lawfully applicable to the purposes of the current fiscal year may be drawn upon by request:


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Chief Financial Officer of Cuyahoga County be and is hereby requested to draw warrants in the maximum sum allowed by law, and the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County be and is hereby requested to pay to the Village of Oakwood any and all tax revenues and payments of special assessments in the County Treasury to the account of the Village of Oakwood and lawfully applicable to the purposes of the fiscal year 2020 including but not limited to the following special assessment accounts: *M305166A 2010 - Sewer, Water, Paving, M555169 2015 - Water-Various Purposes, M605157 9999- Sewer-Various Purposes, and M315159 2022 - Paving, Grading, Draining.*

**SECTION 2.** The Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to furnish a copy of this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Chief Fiscal Officer.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds ( $\frac{2}{3}$ ) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




