ORDINANCE NO. 2019-73

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PART OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Oakwood, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be updated to reflect legislation enacted by the Ohio General Assembly;

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revision of the Codified Ordinances;

WHEREAS, the codification of such ordinances, together with the new matter to be adopted, the matters to be amended and those to be replaced are before Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (%) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
