ORDINANCE NO. 2019 – 74

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 2010-21 TO ALLOW FOR AN APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR TO THE YOUTH COUNCIL COMMITTEE, AND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 1997-25, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES 2007-06 AND 2016-23, TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO YOUTH COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Council has previously created a committee of Council known as the "Youth Council Committee" in collaboration with Bedford City School District; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to open membership to the Hawthorne Valley Youth Council to residents of the Village not currently serving as members of Village Council:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, Cuyahoga County, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2010-21, which currently reads as follows:

There is hereby created a committee of Village Council to be known as the "Youth Council Committee". Council, by majority vote of all members elected thereto, may appoint a member of Council to act as Chairperson and another member to act a Vice Chairperson of the Youth Council Committee, each of which shall serve a one (1) year term. Subsequent appointments of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson shall be in the same form and for the same term as previously provided herein. Any member of Village Council may be a member of the Youth Council Committee and have equal rights to participate and make recommendations to the Mayor and Village Council concerning the advisability and feasibility of creating a Youth Council within the Village of Oakwood. All meetings of the Youth Council Committee shall be open to the public at all times and notice of the holding of meetings of the Youth Council Committee shall be made in accordance with applicable law.

Shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created a committee of Village Council to be known as the "Youth Council Committee". Council, by majority vote of all members elected thereto, may appoint a member of Council to act as Chairperson and another member to act a Vice Chairperson of the Youth Council Committee, each of which shall serve a one (1) year term. Subsequent appointments of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson shall be in the same form and for the same term as previously provided herein. Any member of Village Council may be a member of the Youth Council Committee and have equal rights to participate and make recommendations to the Mayor and Village Council concerning the advisability and feasibility of creating a Youth Council within the Village of Oakwood. Additionally, the Mayor may appoint one resident of the Village of Oakwood who is not currently serving as a member of Village Council to be a member of the Hawthorne Valley Youth Council who shall serve and be compensated as an

Advisor. All meetings of the Youth Council Committee shall be open to the public at all times and notice of the holding of meetings of the Youth Council Committee shall be made in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 2: Section 4 of Ordinance 1997-25, as amended by Ordinances 2007-06 and 2016-23, which currently reads as follows:

the Chairman of each Board and Commission, including the Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, shall receive Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00) per meeting, and each member of the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Recreation Board, Civil Service Commission, Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, the Architectural Board of Review and members of Oakwood Council who serve as HVYC Youth Council Advisors shall be paid compensation at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per meeting for attendance at regular and special meetings of the Board, or Commission or Committee of which they are a member. Compensation shall be paid to Chairmen and members quarterly. No compensation shall be paid to any Chairman, or member or Oakwood HVYC Advisor for meetings they fail to attend nor shall any compensation be paid to any Chairman or member for attendance at any meeting for which a quorum is not present. Chairman and members of the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Civil Service Commission, Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, and the Architectural Board of Review shall be allowed no more than two field trips per year, by consent of the majority vote of the Board, Commission or Committee members, and shall be paid the same compensation, per diem, as for attendance at a regular meeting.

Shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Chairman of each Board and Commission, including the Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, shall receive Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00) per meeting. Each member of the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Recreation Board, Civil Service Commission, Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, the Architectural Board of Review and Hawthorne Valley Youth Council Advisors shall be paid compensation at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per meeting for attendance at regular and special meetings of the Board, Commission, Committee or Council of which they are a member. Compensation shall be paid to Chairmen, members and Advisors quarterly. No compensation shall be paid to any Chairman, member or Advisor for meetings they fail to attend nor shall any compensation be paid to any Chairman, member or Advisor for attendance at any meeting for which a quorum is not present. Chairman and members of the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Civil Service Commission, Oakwood Scholarship Awards Committee, and the Architectural Board of Review shall be allowed no more than two field trips per year, by consent of the majority vote of the Board, Commission or Committee members, and shall be paid the same compensation, per diem, as for attendance at a regular meeting.

SECTION 3. Existing Ordinances 1997-25 and 2010-21, as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinances is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to daily operation of a

municipal department, and therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all
members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the
earliest period allowed by law.
