ORDINANCE NO. 2019-18

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN FORMS FOR THE RENTAL OF THE COMMUNITY CENTER AND THE FEES ASSOCIATED THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend the current forms associated with the rental of the Village=s Community Center and amend certain fees associated therewith:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Council hereby adopts and approves the amended Community Center Rental Agreement and the Community Center Inspection Report, and the fees provided therein, copies of which are attached hereto, expressly made a part hereof by reference, and marked Exhibits "A" and "B".

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2008-15 and all other legislation inconsistent with the terms expressed in this Ordinance and any attachments thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed from and after the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
