## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 25**

## INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

A RESOLUTION REFERRING TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION A PROPOSED ORDINANCE REPEALING OAKWOOD VILLAGE CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTIONS 1169.03(b)(3)(H), 1173.02(a)(4) AND 1173.03(a)(4) AND ENACTING OAKWOOD VILLAGE CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 1175.01(48) SO AS TO PROHIBIT STORAGE AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES WITHIN THE VILLAGE AS PERMITTED OR CONDITIONAL MAIN USES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council, under authority of Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Section 1151.01, deems it advisable to repeal Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Sections 1169.03(b)(3)(H), 1173.02(a)(4) and 1173.03(a)(4) so as to eliminate storage and distribution facilities as permitted or conditional main uses within the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council, under authority of Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Section 1151.01, deems it advisable to enact Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Section 1175.01(48) so as to prohibit storage and distribution facilities as permitted or conditional main uses within the Village; and,

WHEREAS, Oakwood Village Charter Section 10.02(C) requires that, prior to passage, any Ordinance referring to zoning be submitted to the Planning Commission for report and recommendation;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Proposed Ordinance No. 2019 - , attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference and marked Exhibit "A", which repeals Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Sections 1169.03(b)(3)(H), 1173.02(a)(4) and 1173.03(a)(4) so as to eliminate storage and distribution facilities as permitted or conditional main uses within the Village and enacts Oakwood Village Codified Ordinance Section 1175.01(48) so as to prohibit storage and distribution facilities as permitted or conditional main uses within the Village be and hereby is referred to the Planning Commission pursuant to Oakwood Village Charter Section 10.02(C) for report and recommendation.

**SECTION 2.** The Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to refer the attached proposed Ordinance No. 2019 - to the Planning Commission for report and recommendation pursuant to Oakwood Village Charter Section 10.02(C) and the Codified Ordinances of the Village.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a

municipal department and potential economic development activities adverse to the interests of the Village, its citizens and persons working within the Village and, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
