INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE'S PARTICIPATION IN A PROJECT TO MAKE CONCRETE PAVEMENT REPAIRS ON COLUMBUS ROAD FROM RICHMOND ROAD TO THE WEST CORPORATION LINE WITH THE CITY OF BEDFORD HEIGHTS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE OF THIS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN ENIERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of all of the Village residents to continue to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bedford Heights has entered into a contract with Set In Stone Contracting, LLC for the Columbus Road Concrete Repair Project, for a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$290,500.00), as more fully described in the contract documents on file in the Office of the Finance Director in the City of Bedford Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford Heights has requested the Village's participation in the Columbus Road Concrete Repair Project and has proposed to pay 100% of the engineering and inspections cost and the traffic maintenance cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford Heights has proposed that the Village of Oakwood pay for only the actual construction cost, per the Columbus Road Concrete Repair Project contract document line items, for work performed on Columbus Road within the Village of Oakwood as directed and marked by the Oakwood Service Director and Engineer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Oakwood is hereby authorized to participate in a joint project with the City of Bedford Heights to make concrete repairs on Columbus Road with the Village of Oakwood to be invoiced by the City of Bedford Heights for the work performed within the Village of Oakwood from Richmond Road to the west corporation line with the City of Bedford Heights.

SECTION 2. That the Village of Oakwood's cost shall not exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50,000.00) and will be based on the areas of repair to be marked in the field as determined by the Service Director and the Engineer.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents in furtherance of the intents of this authorization.

SECTION 4. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an aggregate amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50,000.00) for concrete road repairs as provided in

Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the SCMR Fund.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
