WHEREAS, the former St. Peter Chanel High School (Chanel) served the educational

needs of generations of students in and around the Bedford City School District for generations; and

WHEREAS, Chanel has ceased operations and its former facility is now owned by the Board of Education of the Bedford City School District (Board); and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the Village of Oakwood that the Board is considering the demolition of the Chanel facility; and

WHEREAS, many businesses in Oakwood and surrounding cities have been looking for and having difficulties finding focused and skilled employees for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, Oakwood has attempted to alleviate this shortage, in part, through the educational component of the five-week Oakwood Summer Camp which efforts cannot succeed alone; and

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. In the strongest terms the Mayor and Council of Oakwood Village unanimously advocate preserving and renovating the former St. Peter Chanel High School facility and devoting it to the establishment of a trade and vocational school or, alternatively, reopening Chanel as a school for public education.

**SECTION 2.** The Clerk is hereby authorized to present a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Education of the Bedford City School District.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the Resolution is necessary to prevent the imminent demolition of the former Chanel facility which could otherwise be used to improve educational opportunities for citizens of the Village and which must be promptly acted upon for the economic benefit of the Village and its residents and, therefore, provided it receives twothirds of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
