

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 54

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
VILLAGE ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND
SPECIFICATIONS, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS, AND
PROCEED WITH ROAD REPAIRS ON VARIOUS
STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE**

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of all of the Village residents to continue to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various streets within the Village:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Village Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for Road Repairs, as determined by the Engineer, for the Village streets or areas as delineated in Exhibit "A", a copy of which is attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof by reference. In addition, the Engineer shall assist the Service Director with the coordination of crack sealing areas delineated in Exhibit "A" utilizing Village Service Department personnel. The Village Engineer is also authorized to perform miscellaneous pavement spot repairs throughout the Village as determined by the Service Director and the Mayor.

SECTION 2. The Village Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids according to law for the repairs and other work as specified in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. Upon receipt of the bids, the Mayor shall provide all members of Council with a bid tabulation summary for each bidder prior to the Board of Control awarding any contract for the matters described in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 4. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an aggregate amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for asphalt and concrete road repairs and other repairs as provided in Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof upon the award of contracts pursuant to Board of Control approval, said amounts to be charged to the SCMR Fund.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (b) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
