ORDINANCE NO. 2019 -63

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH FNB COMMERCIAL LEASING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A VANGUARD SKAG LAWN MOWER FOR SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A STRYKER HEART MONITOR FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND A TRAFFIC SPEED ALERT SIGN WITH TRAILER FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Oakwood has enrolled in the Cooperative Purchasing Program which allows it to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and other materials; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Oakwood is desirous of acquiring a Skag lawn mower, Stryker Fire Equipment, and Speed Alert Radar Message Signage with Trailer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 735.053 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village of Oakwood deems it cost effective to said items from the State of Ohio through its designated vendor;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon the approval of the Board of Control, to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village of Oakwood with the designated vendor of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services - State Purchasing, FNB Commercial Leasing, for the lease/purchase of the following upon the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$52,165.00 to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the Fund No. 401.7799.55110

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants

of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department and the ability to provide safe and effective emergency medical services as well as other services to the citizens of the Village, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (%) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
