WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 735.053 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village of Oakwood deems it cost effective to purchase certain police cars and other vehicles from the State of Ohio through its designated vendor;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed, upon the approval of the Board of Control, to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village of Oakwood with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services - State Purchasing, through its designated vendor(s), Liberty Auto Group, for the purchase or lease of the following vehicles for use in the Building department:

SECTION 2. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$58,922.26 to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the Fund 401.7799.55120 Capital Lease Fund.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department and the imminent need to replace vehicles for those departments, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (¾) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
