**WHEREAS;** Covid-19, otherwise known as Coronavirus, has impacted the United States, individual States, and local municipalities socially and economically; and

**WHEREAS,** to slow the spread of the virus, most businesses have been halted or operate on reduced personnel; and

**WHEREAS,** most funding for municipalities comes from the payroll tax from operating businesses within its jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS,** without municipalities flexibility to use funds to replace lost revenues as a result of the economic impact of Covid-19, municipalities face layoffs, furloughs, and reductions in critical services; and

**WHEREAS,** Ohio's cities and villages need a direct allocation of federal funds to each and every local government regardless of population to ensure vital services are not compromised; and

**NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT** by the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council and Mayor urge Ohio's Congressional Delegation and the U.S. Congress to pass the Emergency Coronavirus Package directed toward funding municipalities in this critical time.

**SECTION 2.** The Clerk is hereby authorized to present a copy of this resolution to the Ohio Delegation members.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approved by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
