#### **Early Notification Program**

Oakwood Village Police Department has implemented an Early Notification Program which was developed in response to the Ohio House Bill 115 to provide First Responders with information to assist calls involving individuals with communication disabilities.

Officers will be better equipped to understand and respond to an emergency situation should it arise.

The following represents individuals who could potentially benefit from the program. It is not intended to be all inclusive, as each request is evaluated on a case by case basis.
