## RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 39

## INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD FROM THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND AS A RESULT OF FUNDING BY THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) WILL BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR PURPOSES AUTHORIZED BY THE CARES ACT AND ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS AND WILL OTHERWISE BE HANDLED AND ACCOUNTED FOR AS REQUIRED BY SAID ACT AND REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act in Amended Senate Bill 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (Am. S.B. 310); and,

WHEREAS, Am. S.B. 310 requires political subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of that Act to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the Cuyahoga County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund (CCRDF) may be expended only to cover costs of the political subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, Oakwood Village is requesting its share of funds from the Cuyahoga County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

**SECTION 1.** The Finance Director of the Village is hereby directed to create a fund to be named the "Local Coronavirus Relief Fund" (LCRF) and to deposit into the LCRF all funds received from the CCRDF.

**SECTION 2.** The Council of the Village of Oakwood affirms that all funds received from the CCRDFpursuant to Am. S.B. 310 shall be expended only to cover costs of the Village consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance to include expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in Oakwood Village's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ending on

**SECTION 3.** In compliance with Am. S.B. 310, the Finance Director of the Village shall take all necessary action to:

- (1) Pay any unencumbered balance of money in the LCRF to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer on or before October 15, 2020;
- (2) Pay the balance of any money in the LCRF to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management on or before December 28, 2020; and
- (3) Provide any information related to any payments received under S.B. 310 to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.

**SECTION 4.** The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer and the Director of the Ohio Office of Management and Budget at the earliest possible date.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department and funding opportunities to assist in overcoming fiscal difficulties caused by COVID-19 pandemic which must be promptly acted upon for the economic benefit of the Village and its residents and, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
