## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BLACK LIVES MATTER

WHEREAS, Black Lives Matter; and,

**WHEREAS,** Black Lives Matter protests have swept the nation as demonstrators seek justice in response to the killings of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, Ahmaud Arbery and numerous other Black Americans; and

**WHEREAS,** Black Lives Matter has articulated the injustices that frequently exist at the intersections of race, class and gender; and

**WHEREAS,** Black Lives Matter works vigorously for freedom, justice, and equality for Black people, all people of color, and by extension, all people; and

**WHEREAS**, Oakwood Village is a community that embraces the effects and advocacy of Black Lives Matter, as well as values civil rights, peace and equality under the law for all people regardless of their identity or identities; and

**NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED** by the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

- **SECTION 1.** The Village Council and Mayor stand in solidarity with all efforts to effect change directed at equal justice and opportunity for all through peaceful protest, expressions of opinion and all other legal and non-violent means.
- **SECTION 2.** The Clerk is hereby authorized to send a copy of this resolution to Senator Rob Portman, Senator Sherrod Brown, and Congresswoman Marcia L. Fudge.
- **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approved by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
