## A RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION TO KEYLEN MERCHANT FOR DISPLAYING BRAVERY AND COMPOSURE WHILE SAVING HIS GRANDMOTHER'S LIFE



**WHEREAS**, Keylen is the seven-year-old son of Travies Merchant (Oakwood, OH) and Richard Freeman (Lorain, OH) and beloved grandson of Marie and Richard Freeman of Oakwood Village; and

WHEREAS, Keylen refers to his Grandmother Marie Freeman simply as 'Grammy'. She refers to him lovingly as 'Pudder'. While in Bedford Heights, Grammy experienced a bad headache and shortly thereafter fell to the ground. Keylen, although frightened,

went into action. He called 9-1-1 for help; and

**WHEREAS**, while on the phone with dispatch, he also summoned help from a neighbor. He further kept his little five-year old brother, Richard, calm while waiting for emergency services to arrive and during the entire frightening event; and

**WHEREAS**, this amazing, active, inquisitive, young boy attends Glendale Elementary School and is in the first grade. He enjoys identifying high end cars as Lamborghini, Bugatti, Porsche, Rolls-Royce among others; and

**WHEREAS**, Grammy was hospitalized four days and spent two of those days in ICU prior to being released. She is extremely proud of Pudder and realizes without his assistance and calm demeanor, the outcome could have been very different; and

**NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT** by the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council and Mayor wish to express their most sincere gratitude to Keylen Merchant for his courage and quick action in saving the life of his Grammy, Marie Freeman, on June 11, 2020.
