RESOLUTION NO.: 2020-75

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BEDFORD FOR THE RESURFACING OF FORBES ROAD FROM BROADWAY AVENUE TO NORTHFIELD ROAD IN THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Director and the Village Engineer have advised the Mayor that Forbes Road from Broadway Avenue to Northfield Road is in need of resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford has entered into a contract with Burton Scot Contractors to conduct resurfacing operations in the City of Bedford on Forbes Road between Northfield Road and Broadway Avenue; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bedford and Burton Scot Contractors have agreed to conduct additional resurfacing operations in the Village of Oakwood on Forbes Road between Northfield Road and Broadway Avenue at contract cost and per the terms of the Cooperative Agreement attached herein as "Exhibit 1"; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director and the Village Engineer have advised the Mayor that resurfacing Forbes Road from Broadway Avenue to Northfield Road in the Village of Oakwood per the terms of the Cooperative Agreement is a cost effective option that will save the Village redundant soft costs including but not limited to engineering design, preparation of plans and specifications, advertising for bids, contract administration and hard costs including, but not limited to bonding and maintenance of traffic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Bedford for the resurfacing of Forbes Road from Broadway Avenue to Northfield Road in the Village of Oakwood.
- Section 2. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an aggregate amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the resurfacing of Forbes Road from Broadway Avenue to Northfield Road as provided in Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof upon submission of invoices from the City of Bedford and as approved by the Village Engineer, said amounts to be charged to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund.
- Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the City of Bedford plans to immediately begin resurfacing operations, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

Between

The Village of Oakwood

and

The City of Bedford

The Village of Oakwood and the City of Bedford are entering into a cooperative agreement which will allow for the City of Bedford to conduct resurfacing operations in the Village Oakwood on Forbes Road between Northfield Road and Broadway Avenue. The work will be performed by Burton Scot Contractors under the existing contract held by the City of Bedford for the reconstruction of Forbes Road in the City of Bedford.

The Village of Oakwood will provide pay for 100% of the costs of all work associated with the resurfacing operations within the Village of Oakwood. The resurfacing shall consist of asphalt surface grinding to a depth of 1.5 inches and the placement of 1.5 inches of new surface course asphalt. The Village of Oakwood will pay for 100% of the costs of remobilization and maintenance of traffic as required to resurface the eastbound lane (south side) of Forbes Road which will be billed as an extra work order by Burton Scot Contractors. The cost for this extra work, per Burton Scot Contractors, will be Two Thousand and Nine Hundred Dollars (\$2,900.00).

The City of Bedford will pay for the costs of all work associated with the resurfacing operations located within the City of Bedford as shown in the attached schematic drawing.

Final distribution of costs will be based on actual cost of work that occurred in each community. Quantities shall be determined by use of the schematic drawing and neat line calculations to be agreed upon by the Oakwood Village Engineer and the Bedford City Engineer. Weight tickets shall be used to determine total quantities only. The Village of Oakwood shall also pay the City of Bedford the cost of inspection for all work performed within Oakwood Village and a sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) to offset additional engineering and contract administration costs resulting from the inclusion of the Oakwood Village portion of the resurfacing of Forbes Road.

The Village of Oakwood agrees to pay its share of the cost, as the invoice is presented, no later than October 15, 2020.
