## **COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT**

Between

## The Village of Oakwood

and

## The City of Bedford

The Village of Oakwood and the City of Bedford are entering into a cooperative agreement which will allow for the City of Bedford to conduct resurfacing operations in the Village Oakwood on Forbes Road between Northfield Road and Broadway Avenue. The work will be performed by Burton Scot Contractors under the existing contract held by the City of Bedford for the reconstruction of Forbes Road in the City of Bedford.

The Village of Oakwood will provide pay for 100% of the costs of all work associated with the resurfacing operations within the Village of Oakwood. The resurfacing shall consist of asphalt surface grinding to a depth of 1.5 inches and the placement of 1.5 inches of new surface course asphalt. The Village of Oakwood will pay for 100% of the costs of remobilization and maintenance of traffic as required to resurface the eastbound lane (south side) of Forbes Road which will be billed as an extra work order by Burton Scot Contractors. The cost for this extra work, per Burton Scot Contractors, will be Two Thousand and Nine Hundred Dollars (\$2,900.00).

The City of Bedford will pay for the costs of all work associated with the resurfacing operations located within the City of Bedford as shown in the attached schematic drawing.

Final distribution of costs will be based on actual cost of work that occurred in each community. Quantities shall be determined by use of the schematic drawing and neat line calculations to be agreed upon by the Oakwood Village Engineer and the Bedford City Engineer. Weight tickets shall be used to determine total quantities only. The Village of Oakwood shall also pay the City of Bedford the cost of inspection for all work performed within Oakwood Village and a sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) to offset additional engineering and contract administration costs resulting from the inclusion of the Oakwood Village portion of the resurfacing of Forbes Road.

The Village of Oakwood agrees to pay its share of the cost, as the invoice is presented, no later than October 15, 2020.
