FREE Reusable Shopping Bags

Leaf Pick-up happens mid-October each year until the weather becomes too inclement to do so. Remember to place leaves in a pile or piles at the front edge of your property near but NOT ON the roadway. No branches, twigs, rocks, or debris. If these are present, pick up will NOT take place.

Branches or brush may be tied together in four-foot bundles for regular Monday trash pick-up.



Large Items – Waste Management (WM)

Your WM issued bin lid should be closed for pick up. Also, WM is now taking large items at the curb with a few stipulations. Wrap furniture in plastic AND call 440.287.7575 for a special pick-up 24-hour advance notice is required. WM will not pick up large items unless a special pick up is scheduled.

New Snow Removal Policy

For those 62 or older, or permanently disabled and you have no one else residing at your home to shovel your driveway, you **may register** for the snow removal program. For eligible participants, applications and release forms can be filled out at Village Hall or downloaded from the website (www.oakwoodvillageoh.com/service). A one-time \$1.00 registration fee will entitle you to have your driveway shoveled the entire winter when 3" or more of snow falls and the streets have been cleared. **Apply annually** at the Village Hall **by December 4th** to continue participation. **If you do not meet the criteria stated above, please do not abuse this service.**

If you have previously registered for this program, the **form must still be completed annually** to remain in the program. Registration begins October 12th until November 20th. Thereafter a \$10 fee will be incurred. No applications will be processed after **December 4th**.

Election Update

This year, the Charter Review Commission met and recommended seven (7) issues to Council for placement on the ballot this November. Oakwood Village Council passed the ordinances below to be put before the voters.

| 2020-44 | Shall Section 10.06 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood pertaining to the Civil Service Commission be repealed? |
| 2020-45 | Shall Section 6.01 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended that Regular and Primary Municipal elections shall be held on the dates specified in Section 3501.01 of the Ohio Revised Code or as otherwise provided in the Ohio Constitution or Ohio Revised Code? |
| 2020-46 | Shall Section 6.05 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended to eliminate the requirement that a candidate for office is not eligible to file a nominating petition if he or she holds a different elective office of the Village at the time of filing said petition? |
| 2020-47 | Shall Section 7.07 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended to provide that an appointment to Council will hold such office until the next election for said office? |
| 2020-48 | Shall Section 7.13 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended to provide that Council may, by a vote of three fourths (3/4) of its members, dispense with three readings of any ordinances(s)? |
| 2020-49 | Shall Section 7.14 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended to provide that all ordinances and resolutions shall be published by posting copies in the lobby of the Village Hall and on the official Village website plus one other public place in the Municipality to be identified on the Village website; and that the Clerk shall make and sign a certificate as to such postings? |
| 2020-51 | Shall Section 8.04 of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood providing for any full-time employee of the Municipality shall have and enjoy such rights to a hearing of charges against him, in case of threatened removal or suspension, and to an appeal, as may be provided by the general laws of Ohio or by the Council, where it is competent for the Council to act. This section shall not be in force and effect and after the municipality becomes a City be repealed? |
