Snow Removal Program



Residents age 62 years & older, or those permanently disabled & without anyone else younger living at your home that could shovel, you can register at Village Hall for our Snow Removal Program.

For eligible first-timers, a \$1.00 registration fee will entitle you to have your driveway shoveled when

at least 4" or more of snow has fallen & all major streets in Oakwood have been plowed.

If you've previously registered for this program, you must still come in to reregister to remain in the program.

Late registration will be from Nov. 23rd until Dec 6th. A \$10 late fee will be charged & must be paid at Village Hall prior to being placed on the list.

Fall Leaf Collection

The Oakwood Service Dept. will begin its **LEAF COLLECTION IN LATE-OCTOBER.** Rake leaves onto your tree lawn and remove branches, twigs, rocks and other debris. **Piles that contain items other than leaves WILL NOT be picked up.** If you have branches or brush, you may tie them into small bundles no more than 4-feet long for regular Monday trash pick up. **Do not place leaves on the roadway.**

The Service Dept. will make recurring trips around the Village until the weather becomes inclement.
