AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS, AND PROCEED WITH ROAD REPAIRS ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROUTES LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of all of the Village residents to continue to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various streets within the Village, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Engineer have applied for funding from the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works to reimburse the Village for the cost of materials purchased to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various Cuyahoga County routes located within the Village, and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works has notified the Mayor that it will reimburse the Village for the cost of materials purchased to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on Broadway Avenue (from Interstates 271/480 to Richmond Road), Richmond Road (from Columbus Road to Broadway Avenue) and Tryon Road (from Richmond Road to Broadway Avenue) for an amount of up to Thirty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$30,750.00).

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all of the Village residents to continue to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various streets within the Village:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Village Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for Road Repairs, as determined by the Engineer, on Broadway Avenue (from Interstates 271/480 to Richmond Road), Richmond Road (from Columbus Road to Broadway Avenue) and Tryon Road (from Richmond Road to Broadway Avenue). The Village Engineer be and is also hereby authorized to perform miscellaneous pavement spot repairs throughout the Village as determined by the Service Director and the Mayor.

SECTION 2. The Village Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids according to law for the repairs and other work as specified in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. Upon receipt of the bids, the Mayor shall provide all members of Council with a bid tabulation summary for each bidder prior to the Board of Control awarding any contract pertaining to the matters described in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 4. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an aggregate amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) for asphalt and concrete road repairs and other repairs as provided in Section 1 hereof. The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and

directed to issue vouchers in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof upon the award of contracts pursuant to Board of Control approval, said amounts to be charged to the SCMR Fund.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village, the reason for the emergency being that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
