WHEREAS, friends and family came from great distances to show Jerry their love and appreciation through his birthday celebration which was highlighted by entertaining and informational testimonials; and


WHEREAS, fun was had by all who attended this blessed event for Jerry.

SECTION 1. The Village Council and Mayor wish Jerry the best and continued health and happiness for many years to come.


