Snow Removal Program

Residents 62 years of age or older or those disabled without anyone younger at home to shovel the driveway, can register at Village Hall for snow removal.

For eligible first timers, a \$1.00 registration fee will entitle your driveway plowed when at least 4" or more snow has fallen and all main and residential streets have been cleared. If you have previously registered for this program call Village 440-232-9988 to continue participation.
