## ORDINANCE NO. 2022-39

## INTRODUCED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

## AN ORDINANCE TO EXEMPT ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD FROM THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DISPOSABLE BAG BAN, ORDINANCE 02019-0005.

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Council passed Cuyahoga County Ordinance No. O2019-005, which prohibits the use of disposable plastic bags and non-permitted paper bags by retail establishments in Cuyahoga County beginning on January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council passed said legislation without seeking the input of the cities and communities in Cuyahoga County that will be affected by it; and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County Ordinance No. O2019-0005 places an undue burden on the business community in the Village of Oakwood, as well as the residents of the Village of Oakwood, by imposing restrictions set forth in said Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the specific intention of the Village of Oakwood to employ its homerule authority to exempt the Village of Oakwood business establishments, along with any person or entity within the Village of Oakwood, from the provisions of Cuyahoga County Ordinance No. O2019-0005.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Council of the Village of Oakwood expressly exempts all business establishments, along with any person or entity within the Village of Oakwood from Cuyahoga County Ordinance No. O2019-0005.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
