RESOLUTION NO. 2022-48

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COUNTYWIDE ALL-NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN FOR CUYAHOGA COUNTY

- WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires that all communities desiring to participate in mitigation programs to establish an all-natural hazard mitigation plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Village of Oakwood acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Village of Oakwood; and
- **WHEREAS**, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments; and
- WHEREAS, there must be documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the government body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan; and
- WHEREAS, each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that the plan has been formally adopted.
- **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio that:
- <u>SECTION 1</u>. The Village of Oakwood hereby adopts as its official Hazard Mitigation Plan the "Countywide All-Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan for Cuyahoga County, 2022-2027 Update".
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and the Fire Chief are hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to formally adopt this plan on behalf of the Village and to execute whatever documentation is necessary to acknowledge the Village's adoption of this plan.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village. The reason for the emergency, Oakwood Village is most vulnerable to natural, and human made hazards, and the community is required to formally adopt the updated plan. Therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (¾) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
