PHILOSOPHY AND PURPOSE FRAMEWORK

To facilitate and support early literacy growth at the Cuyahoga County Public Library we have partnered with Innovations for Learning and their evidence-based high dosage tutoring curriculum. This program focuses on individual student coaching and direct instruction in early literacy skills and subsequent skills practice using the ChapterOne online tool.

Program Structure

Each student will have two scheduled 30-minute sessions each week.

1. One on One instruction

The first 15 minute period will consist of one-on-one coaching with the 123 BOOST Coordinator.

- Focus on phonics, phonemic awareness, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing

2. Supported Practice

The second 15 minute period will consist of guided practice using the ChapterOne early literacy tool.

- Focus on literacy through exploration and play
