AN ORDINANCE REORGANIZING THE CLERK OF COURTS OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Oakwood Mayor's Court no longer hears cases and operates only as a violations bureau which has significantly decreased the workload of the Clerk of Courts office; and,

WHEREAS, given the foregoing change and other economic developments, Council finds it necessary to reorganize the positions authorized in the Clerk of Courts office;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Effective August 1, 2026, the Clerk of Courts position is re-classified to part-time with the Clerk to work a maximum twenty (20) hours per week through December 31, 2026 after which the position shall be abolished.

SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2027, the position of Chief Deputy Clerk of the Oakwood Mayor's Court shall be entitled Mayor's Court Clerk and shall perform all duties presently performed by the Clerk of Courts and Assistant Clerk of Courts.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
