

ORDINANCE NO.: 2026 – 85

INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBER: 2026-61; 2026-62; 2026-68; 2026-69; 2026-72; 2026-73; 2026-74; 2026-76; 2026-77; 2026-78; and 2026-80, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2026, Ordinance Nos. 2026-61; 2026-62; 2026-68; 2026-69; 2026-72; 2026-73; 2026-74; 2026-76; 2026-77; 2026-78; and 2026-80 were approved by this Council; and

WHEREAS, Council now seeks to repeal these Ordinances in order to remove those proposed amendments from consideration on the November 3, 2026 election.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Oakwood, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Ordinances No. 2026-61; 2026-62; 2026-68; 2026-69; 2026-72; 2026-73; 2026-74; 2026-76; 2026-77; 2026-78; and 2026-80 as originally approved on August 20, 2026 are hereby repealed.

Section 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed not to forward copies of the above referenced Ordinances to the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Oakwood and for the reason that it is necessary to repeal these Ordinances prior to submission of the Charter Amendments to the Board of Elections and, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

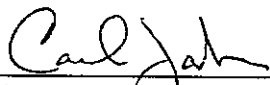
